

Setting Internet and MMS settings on a Series 40 Nokia

Automatic MMS and Internet settings

In case you have the Settings Wizard on your device please follow the next steps.

1. Press the **Menu** key on your phone.
2. Scroll to and select **Tools**. (Note: The location of the Settings Wizard varies according to device).
3. Scroll to and select **Settings Wizard** to launch the Nokia Settings Wizard.
4. Scroll to and select **Operator**.
5. Follow the wizard's on-screen steps to automatically configure the phone with the required operator service settings.
6. The handset will retrieve the correct settings for MMS and Internet and load those on to your device.

Manual Internet settings

In case you don't have the Settings Wizard on your device please follow the next steps.

1. Retrieve the correct Network settings for your device by going to the following pages.

2. Go into the main menu and select **Settings**.
3. In **Settings** go in to **Connectivity** and then select **Packet Data**.
4. Scroll down to **Packet Data** settings.
5. Select **Edit Active Access Point**. Scroll down to **Packet Data Access Point** and select.
6. Insert access point settings from the website above and save.
7. Restart your phone and you now have the correct Network settings.

Manual MMS settings

In case you don't have the Settings Wizard on your device please follow the next steps.

1. Retrieve the correct Network settings for your device by going to the following pages.

2. Once you have the correct MMS settings for your Network go into the main menu and select **Settings**.
3. Scroll down to **Configuration** and press **Select**.
4. Scroll down to **Personal Configuration Settings** and press select. In the next window press **Add** to select a new configuration type.
5. From the various configuration types select **Multimedia messages**.
6. In the new window select **Account Name** and change it to your airtime provider. Once changed click **OK** and scroll down to server address.

7. In the server address menu insert the server address that you got from the above website. Save that and then scroll down to use preferred access point.
8. In the preferred access point select **Yes**. This will push all data over the GPRS connection you created earlier.
9. You have now set up all the required settings for MMS.
10. Switch off the handset and back on again to make sure the settings take affect and then send yourself a test MMS. This will send out an MMS onto the Network and back to your handset to make sure that the loop is working.
